The following list consists of the categories and criteria for the awards being considered for exemplary grade 5 students only

1. School District No. 34 Academic Award: **ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE**

The top Grade 5 student/s in all academics consistently throughout his or her Grade 5 year. Responsible work habits, attentive classroom behavior, and steady growth in knowledge, skills, and attitude that exceeds expectations in all three school terms.

2. Bondar Athletic Award- Top Athlete/s: **OUTSTANDING ATHLETE(S)**

The top Grade 5 student/s in all athletics throughout the Grade 5 year. The top student/s will have demonstrated each of the following skills: a high level of physical skill development, a high degree of involvement in the school's physical education programs-both in class and extra-curricular, a positive attitude, a respect for others, a safe and caring manner, and productive leadership abilities. The outstanding female athlete will have shown herself to be 'coachable'- listening to directions for skill improvement and putting suggestions into place to improve her athletic performance. This student will also be an example for others of good sportsmanship, no matter what the outcome.

3. Bondar Fine Arts Award- Top Grade 5 Artist/s: **EXEMPLARY FINE ARTS**
